 2. Jesus claims all authority has been given to him. He is either the son of God, or something far worse.

2. How do I answer the Question: Who do you say that I am?

- A. The resurrection of Jesus Christ changes everything. The tomb was found empty. (Luke 24:2-3) (1 Cor 15:6)
1. Notice what Paul says, Jesus was raised on the third day according to the scriptures. (1 Cor 15:3-4)
- B. A young man we know as Saul, in a moment, Jesus _____ his life. The greatest opponent to Christianity, became one of the most devoted followers of Jesus. (Col 1:23)

3. What does this mean for you and me?

- A. The essence of Christianity is personal. Jesus was raised for us. (Rom 4:25)
1. We have the forgiveness of sins. Jesus died in spite of everything wrong with us, so that we could have a relationship with God. (2 Cor 5:21) (1 Cor 15:3) (1 Peter 2:24)
