The Search for Happiness

(Psalms 1)

1. Happiness is Fundamental, Not Superficial.

- A. _____ happiness that is held out and offered by God is a fundamental happiness and not a superficial happiness. (Ps. 1:3; Jer. 17:7-8)
1. The tree in this metaphor is subject to seasons.
 2. However, this tree does not wither and die because the roots of this tree has access to a unremitting stream of _____.
- B. What is the point?
1. The first major mistake that so many people make is to think that happiness is found in circumstances, or _____. (1 John 2:17)
 2. As a Christian, our happiness, or blessedness, does not consist in what happens to you, but in what you are. (2 Pet. 1:3-4)
 3. Look at what Peter said in 1 Pet. 1:6. ***“In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials.”***
 - a. This verse uses two present tenses: you are _____, and you are grieved.
 - b. When a Christian goes through droughts of life, they have to put their roots down in Him in a way that they didn't before.
- C. Happiness that the Bible talks about is not lightheartedness all the time. (Ps. 63:7-8)

3. Happiness Can Never Be Found Directly.

- A. Happiness is always a byproduct of _____ something else.
1. Jesus never said, “blessed is the one who hungers and thirst after blessedness, or happiness.” (Matt. 5:6)
 2. If our highest priority is anything else than God, then we will never find happiness.
- B. Is _____ committed to your happiness? Absolutely. (John 10:10; 15:11)
