Happiness is always a byproduct of something else.
1. Jesus never said, "blessed is the one who hungers and thirst after blessedness, or happiness." (Matt. 5:6)
2. If our highest priority is anything else than God, then we will never find happiness. Is committed to your happiness? Absolutely. (John 10:10; 15:11)
1. However, if you simply come to God for Him to make you happy, then you are not going to find happiness.
2 There are only ways to come to God
 There are only ways to come to God. You come to God and say, "I owe you everything and you owe me nothing." (Luke 17:10)
b. Or, you come to God and say, "I'm going to come to you, but then you owe me a lot."
The only way for you to know on what basis you have come is to see what happens in theseasons.
