God works in the mess pt1

1. Rejoice in God's Goodness

- God works in the mess
 - Sin causes us to have to deal with the brokenness of mankind.
- David finds himself rejoicing after running from Saul, and afraid of King Achish. Notice during this he says "... His praise shall continually be in my _____. (1 Samuel 21) (Psalm 34:1)
 - What does it mean to rejoice in God's goodness?
 - In times of _____, we need to learn to find the Joy in the moment. To celebrate God's goodness, no matter what is happening in that moment.
 - David acknowledges that he has fears despite what is going on, he chooses to find God's goodness in those things. (Psalm 34:4)
 - We know through God's love and mercy we find ourselves overcoming and being _____ from those things. (Psalm 145:9)

2. God is near the Brokenhearted

- David doesn't dismiss the trials of Life, but instead he says, "The Lord is near the brokenhearted." (Psalm 34:5, 18)
 - What makes me special? It's my _____ with God. (Proverbs 3:5-6) (Romans 8:28)
- This beautiful Psalm invites us to an understanding of what it means to be spiritually and emotionally mature in how we view the world.

3. God works, and He is Good

- "The Lord redeems the life of his servants" (Psalm 34:22) Sometimes we can't see God's goodness, but it doesn't make it any less real.
 - In spite of my situation, I'm simply going to say God is Good.
- How do I praise God in this situation? God works in all areas of our lives and can turn the worst story into something _____. (Philippians 4:8)
 - God is in Control. Remember what he does for us. (Psalm 34:17-22) (Psalm 103:4-7)
 - If I allow God to work through these moments of sorrow, God can turn it into something commendable, something righteous. He is worthy of our Love and our devotion.
