God's Power to Save

A problem that man has dealt with since the Garden of Eden is the problem of sin. To see the condition of a sinner is to see the necessity of a power of God to save man. Paul says that a sinner is a slave to sin (Rom. 6:17-18). In Luke 15:32, we are told that a sinner is dead in sin. Paul, writing to Timothy, tells us that a sinner is the captive of the devil (2 Tim. 2:24-26). Since God must be the one to save man (1 Tim. 4:10), what power does God use in order to achieve this? The answer is simple. God's power to save is the Gospel (Rom. 1:16).

The real power of the Gospel is that it is a revealer. (Rom. 1:17)

The gospel reveals the "righteousness of God." God makes men righteous by justifying them, or forgiving man of sin. Since all men sin (Rom. 3:23), all men are in need of obtaining the forgiveness of sins. The gospel reveals the unrighteousness of man. One cannot read through the scriptures without coming to an understanding that sin is a problem that every person deals with (1 John 1:8, 10). Therefore, the gospel reveals to man the need to have their sins forgiven so that they can escape the wrath of God.

The Gospel doesn't save because many refuse to believe it. (Rom. 1:16)

Failure to believe the gospel nullifies its power. There are many reasons for which people do not believe the gospel. Pride can keep one from believing in the gospel. Some feel that they are already "good enough." Worldliness can keep one from believing the gospel. Too many have a hard time giving up worldly passions and activities. Yet, if I want to be saved, that is exactly what I must do!

Why doesn't the saving gospel save? The reason is due to the fact that man refuses to let it. In order for the gospel to save, it has to be believed and obeyed (Rom. 6:17). God will only save those who accept His help. My prayer is that everyone who is struggling with sin will decide to obey the gospel and become a child of God.
