God's desire is not to, but to bring about reconciliation between Himself and rebellious mankind. (1 Tim. 2:4; Rom. 5:6-8) B. Becoming a Christian means being reconciled to 1. Paul described his God-appointed mission in 2 Corinthians 5:18-20. 2. The primary mission of the Church is to carry on the apostles' ministry of reconcile ation.
 2. Our Primary Mission is not Worship. A. Because we have been reconciled to God, we have the of worshipping Him. 1. We have been allowed into His presence to sing His praises, to come before His throne in Prayer, to love Him, and to be loved by Him. 2. Worship is B. If we have tasted and seen that the Lord is good, then we should want the world to know the same joy we have in Christ. (Psalm 34:8)
3. Our Primary Mission is not Moral Reform of Our Legal System. A. The church needs to be preaching against immorality, but for the sole purpose of convicting the world of (John 16:8)
