The Search for Identity

(Psalms 8)

There is nothing more characteristic of modern life than the search for identity and for self-esteem. For the most part, this is a very modern problem. Instead of those things that were constant, today there is simply a series of disposable items and situations. I would like to suggest it's very important for us today to understand there are certain theories of identity formation that are reigning.

1. What the World Says.

A. "I am what I _____."

1. This is the approach that says the important thing is get whatever you need to get.
2. Does this approach work? (Matt. 16:26)
3. The word "_____" means "identicalness", or "_____."
4. If you make money, love, or anything else your identity, you will never have a coherent core. (Luke 16:19-21)

B. "I am what I _____."

1. The important thing is not hard work and accomplishment. The important thing is to get in touch with your deepest feelings.
2. This view requires an incredibly flawed assumption.
3. The Bible tells us that we cannot trust our _____. (Pro.3:5; Jer. 17:9)
4. The Bible tells us we are at war within ourselves. (Gal. 5:17)

C. "I am whatever I _____ that I am."

1. "It's oppressive to say I have to be something. It's oppressive to say I have to discover any particular self. All self is constructed. All self is chosen. I am whoever I say I am."
2. The people with this third view, the view of the deconstructionist, say, "It's _____ to tell people they have to live in a certain way."
3. The whole idea behind this view is that there is no such thing as "standard" to which you must bow.
