The Problem of Guilt

I. WG NAVG DGGII JAVGU.	
A. The Bible always teaches that the Christian	from sin. (Acts 2:38; 22:16; Titus 3:5;
Heb. 8:12)	

- 1. Sin is _____ and we need to understand its seriousness. Sin is what separates a person from God. (Isa. 59:1-2; Micah 3:4)
- 2. Sin is lawlessness. It is going against what God has says is right and deserves death. (1 John 3:4; Rom. 6:23)
- B. Being saved from sin means being saved from all the deterioration, all the alienation, and all the disintergration that happens when a person is separated from God. This would include guilt.
- C. As soon as a person submits to God that person is immediately saved from the penalty of sin and there is no longer a need for guilt over past sins. (Rom. 8:1)

2. We Are Being Saved.

We Hove Deep Coved

- A. What does Paul mean when he tells us that we are being saved and that we need to _____ our own salvation? (1 Cor. 1:18; Phil. 2:12)
 - 1. Yes, we have been forgiven of past sins, but there is a lot of clean up that needs to take place. (Rom. 6:12-14)
 - 2. However, this process is _____ and we will continue to struggle against sin. (1 John 1:8, 10)
 - 3. God understands this, so He has made provision for us. (1 John 1:7,9; Matt. 5:4; 2 Cor. 7:10)
- B. Salvation in the present tense is God working in us to become more like His Son. It is being saved from the power of sin.
