1. The Definition of Grace.

- A. That which gives _____, pleasure, and delight.
 - 1. This is the original idea of the word "charis."
 - 2. It is used in the N.T. in this way in reference to speech. (Luke 4:22; Col. 4:6)
- B. Goodwill, lovingkindness, and _____.
 - 1. In this way, it is used of the kindness of a master towards his inferiors or servants. (Eph. 2:5)
 - 2. It is this particular definition of grace that prompts us to think of it most often as "_____ favor."
- C. A spiritual state in which one enjoys God's good favor. (Rom. 5:1-2)

2. What Grace Means to Us.

- A. We are _____ by grace! (Eph. 2:5, 8-9)
 - 1. Salvation is first, foremost, and always a matter of grace! (Rom. 3:23; 6:23)
