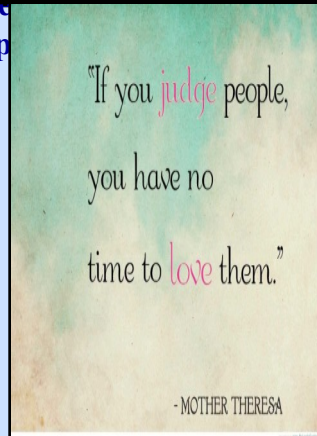

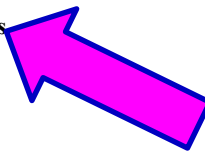

2. How Do We Worship?

- A. We must worship corporately.

- B. We must worship rhythmically.
 1. Notice that the first five verses of this psalm are about _____.
 2. Then, in the middle part, there is submission and confession.
 3. This psalm ends by emphasizing the importance of listening to God's word.
 4. We're talking about a certain rhythm. You see God's greatness. That leads you to think about your littleness, and that leads you to need the word of grace, during the offering or during the Lord's Supper, rethinking his praise and rethinking what you have to change. (Heb. 13:15)
