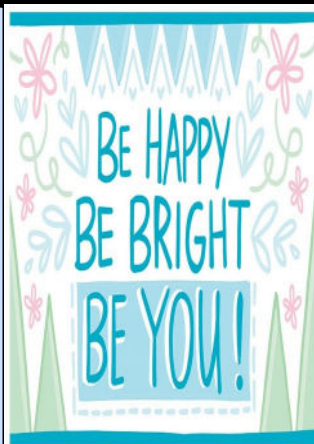

1. The Grace of Singing.

- A. Singing tells us the _____ about God's redemption.
1. What does it mean to be "filled with the Spirit?" (Eph. 5:18-19)
 2. In Acts 2:13, when the Holy Spirit fell on the apostles, the crowd that they were _____. Why?
 - a. Because of how boldly they were proclaiming the gospel of Jesus.

- C. Singing drives the word of God deeper into our hearts. The more we are filled with the Spirit, the word of God dwelling in us, the more we will sing and have those truths become more real to us.

2. The Future of Singing.

- A. The idea of "making melody in our heart to the Lord" is that we are so full of God's reality and salvation, that we automatically sing to God. We sing, or compose melodies, about all kinds of things.
